Subject: 2009–2010 Application to Export Low-Level Radioactive Waste

Attached is an Application to Export Low-Level Radioactive Waste from the Central Interstate LLRW Compact Region for fiscal year 2009-2010. The Commission must approve Export Applications before low-level radioactive waste leaves the Compact region. A waste survey is also enclosed. Please complete the waste survey and return it to the Commission.

If you plan to export low-level radioactive waste from the Compact region for disposal, during fiscal year 2009-2010, please complete the application and return it with the applicable payment to the Commission's office by July 14, 2009.

Applications will be considered for approval at the Commission teleconference July 21, 2009.

PLEASE NOTE:

The Commission has removed the "Occasional Shipper" portion for the Very Small Generator. Generators that used this category will need to apply for authorization to ship in the fiscal year in which they will be shipping for disposal.

A new question at number 7 on the application has been added. The Commission would like to know if you are storing llrw due to the closing of the Energy Solutions disposal facility at Barnwell to out-of-compact waste.
